

## **Resident Forum**

The Resident Forum is an organization for residents and fellows in all programs. The members are selected by their peers. All programs are invited to send one or more representatives to the Forum, which meets at least four times a year. Program Directors are informed about the meetings so that residents/fellows may be released from other responsibilities. The resident representatives select someone to chair and convene the meetings. Representatives from the GME office and the Consortium usually spend 15-20 minutes at the beginning of the meeting with the Forum members so that administrative questions can be answered. The group then meets on its own to discuss issues that cross disciplines and sites. The Forum has historically been key in providing information useful in improving the quality of life for all residents
