

LICENSURE STATUS

To be completed by residents who have a Connecticut medical license from the Department of Health Services.

The State of Connecticut Department of Health Services does not require residents to be licensed to participate in residency training programs. In fact, you must have two years of accredited residency training to qualify for a Connecticut medical license. For more information contact the Department of Health Services, (860) 509-7563.

The Graduate Medical Education Office at the University of Connecticut School of Medicine sends a list of all residents to the State of Connecticut Department of Health Services to inform them of your participation. This is called a permit. There is no certificate or number.

If you currently hold a Connecticut medical license including you on the “permit” list, it could cause problems with your license. To remove your name from the list you must complete the information below and return to Residency Administration, University of Connecticut School of Medicine, 263 Farmington Avenue, Farmington, CT 06030-1925.
