Graduation Requirements and Exit Requirements

Graduating from Residency and/or Entering a Fellowship Program:

In order to graduate from a residency training program at the University of Connecticut School of Medicine, a resident must have passed USMLE Step 3 and must have been evaluated as competent in all six ACGME competencies.

In order to graduate from a fellowship program, residents must have been evaluated as competent in all six ACGME competencies for that fellowship. A resident cannot enter a fellowship program at the University of Connecticut without having successfully completed all USMLE exams.

Program Directors must provide each resident with a Final Summary. The resident must complete the sign-out sheet provided to him/her before the last check will be issued.

Exit Requirements:

Residents leaving the training program are required to attend an "exit interview" conducted by the Capital Area Health Consortium.
