Resident Selection and Resident Agreement

Resident Selection:

Programs select residents from eligible applicants on the basis of resident/program-related criteria such as preparedness, ability, aptitude, academic credentials, communication skills, personal qualities such as motivation and integrity, and other factors. The University of Connecticut School of Medicine is an equal opportunity employer.
