Miscellaneous Benefits

Training and Employment Verification:

When a resident applies for a license or credentials for privileges in a hospital after residency, the GME office will confirm program dates and information on status at the time of termination.

Loan Deferments:

Residents with undergraduate loans are usually eligible for some form of deferment. The GME office will verify residency status and will keep copies of forms sent in the individual resident's file.

DEA Numbers:

Prior to obtaining an individual license to practice Medicine and thereby become eligible for a personal DEA number, each resident is assigned a DEA number for each hospital to which he/she is assigned. The GME office will provide each resident a DEA number for the John Dempsey Hospital (University Hospital). The resident must obtain a separate DEA number at the other hospitals and should check with the program department office at that hospital.

Lab Coats

Residents are entitled to two lab coats, which are distributed by the programs.

Meal Allowance

A meal allowance is added to the resident's stipend for each night, holiday or weekend day he/she is on "in-house" call. In addition to the meal allowance, there is 24-hour access to food at any site at which the resident has overnight call.
